

Bill Mahomes Elected Chairman of the Texas A&M System Board of Regents

DALLAS – Bill Mahomes, of counsel in **Bracewell LLP**'s Dallas office, has been elected chairman of the Texas A&M University System Board of Regents. Mahomes has served on various corporate and civic boards throughout his career, including his current roles on Vista Bank's board of directors and the advisory board of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas.
